Description: In 2009, Wells Fargo Bank, Michael Rose, CPA, the MCJCF and other caring businesses awarded scholarships to deserving Fort Bend County area students who to attend an accredited College or University.

Some of your neighbors, who have received scholarships, attend Baylor University, Stephen F. Austin, Prairie View A & M University, University of Missouri – Columbia, and The University of Texas.

Application Process: Applications may be secured by going online at www.MCJCF.com or calling 281.582.8181 for further instruction.

Official high school transcript including SAT scores and two letters of reference must be submitted with the application.

Selection Criteria: Applicants will be reviewed on (1) educational preparation of candidate, (2) desire of the candidate to attend college, (3) community and/or civic involvement, (4) financial need and (5) content and completeness of application.

Selection Process: Nominees will be selected by the MCJCF Advisory Board. Top candidates will be selected on the basis of written applications and may be interviewed by the selection committee prior to final selection.

Confidentiality: All information submitted by the applicant will be held in strict confidence by the scholarship committee and used only with the prior consent of the applicant.

Selection Criteria and Guidelines

1. Nominee must complete the scholarship application and fulfill all requirements. Deadline for application receipt is **June 19, 2011**. (Application must be in the hands of the MCJCF Scholarship Selection Committee or post-marked June 19, 2011).
2. Nominee must be a Fort Bend County School District attendee, and must be planning to attend an accredited college or university.
3. Candidates must be willing to submit to interview/s by the MCJCF Selection Committee.
4. The scholarship is not transferable and may not be sold or used by anyone other than the applicant. If the winner cannot attend one of the above referenced schools, the Scholarship Committee must be notified.
5. If selected, nominee **must attend** the MCJCF Community Service Awards Gala and participate in the "Mile of Smiles" parade the following year.
6. The scholarship will be awarded to the selected students upon presentation of an acceptance letter and evidence of registration from the enrolled university or college.
