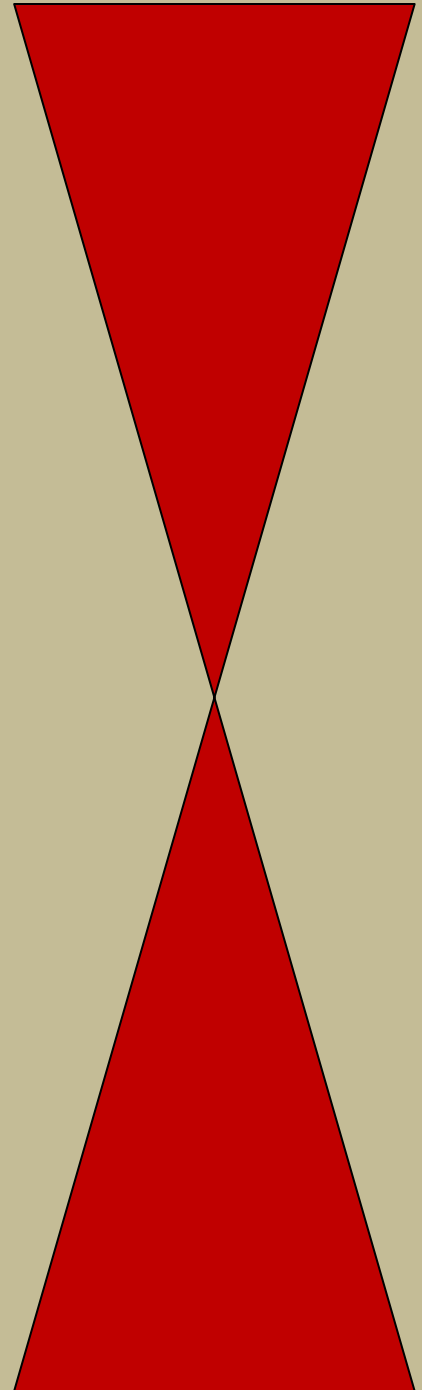
Ms. Stewart, a Missouri City native, is the keynote speaker for the MCJCF's 2011 Annual Community Service Awards Gala.
