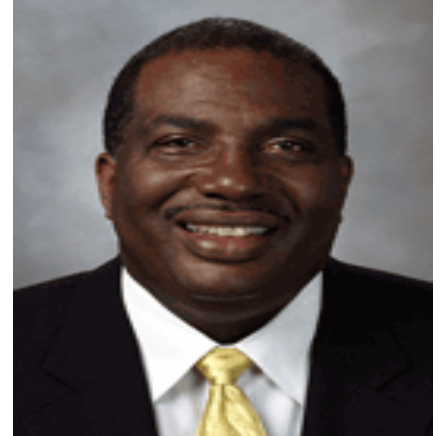

Senator West was installed as State Senator, District 23 (Dallas County), in January 1993 after winning the election for the Senate seat in November 1992. He has represented the 23rd Senatorial District in the 73rd, 74th, 75th, 76th, 77th, 78th, 79th, 80th, and 81st Legislative Sessions. In 2005 *Texas Monthly Magazine* named **Senator West** as one of the 25 most powerful people in Texas politics. Over the course of his legislative tenure, the magazine chose Senator West as one of the "Ten Best Legislators in Texas" and twice named him as an "Honorable Mention." The *Associated Press* named **Senator West** as one of the "key players of the 2005 Legislature" in its "Movers and Shakers" list. *Texas Insider* named Senator West to its 2009 "Best Legislators" list.
